Everyday: those places we inhabit or the things we handle daily. Whether kitchens, sinks, pots or pans, all have a quiet beauty that goes beyond their ordinary use.

The places and details depicted in this exhibition include some well-known locations in London, such as Scotti's Snack Bar on Clerkenwell Green or the Quality Chop House in Farringdon; others are in Cornwall, Wales and the Lake District.

Whether the subjects are familiar cafés, restaurants or private homes, the owners make their presence felt by those things they use every day...

This work continues Eleanor's interest in the play of light across the interiors of cafés and domestic settings. These are mostly unpeopled spaces, although sometimes a figure is quietly absorbed in their work.

These are all objects and places for everyday, perhaps mundane, but always quietly beautiful.

Eleanor Crow is an artist who has exhibited widely, and whose book of watercolours *Shopfronts of London* was published by Spitalfields Life Books with Batsford Books in 2019.
